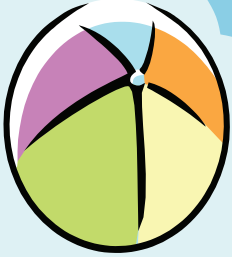


JUNIOR RECREATION LEADER SUMMER PROGRAM

Each participant will function as a junior staff assigned to a specific program, event

or activity. Junior Recreation Leaders are responsible for assisting Recreation Staff in leading games, activities, and various other duties. Examples of assignments include Summer Blaze Day Camp and Cityhood Celebration. For those interested, this volunteer position may be utilized as community service hours. Each participant is required to fill out a volunteer application/waiver and participate in an interview process prior to being accepted into the Junior Recreation Leader Program. All training dates must be attended.



Summer hours will vary and Junior Recreation Leaders will receive a weekly staff schedule.

Experience working with children is preferred, however not required.

Program requirements are strictly youth ages 13 to 16.
